- **PURPLE AND PURPLE WITH BLACK STRIPE:** REAR RIGHT SPEAKER POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE
- **ORANGE:** ILLUMINATION/DIMMER CONTROL
- **BLUE:** REMOTE TURN-ON FOR AMPLIFIER OR ANTENNA

HOW TO READ AND USE THE WIRING DIAGRAM
