UNDERSTANDING THE 2001 NISSAN FRONTIER BELT SYSTEM

THE 2001 NISSAN FRONTIER UTILIZES A COMBINATION OF BELTS TO DRIVE VARIOUS ENGINE COMPONENTS ESSENTIAL TO THE VEHICLE'S OPERATION. THE PRIMARY BELTS INCLUDE THE SERPENTINE BELT, WHICH POWERS MULTIPLE ACCESSORIES, AND THE TIMING BELT, WHICH SYNCHRONIZES THE ENGINE'S CAMSHAFT AND CRANKSHAFT.
