ORIGINS AND PUBLICATION HISTORY

FRANK LESLIE'S ILLUSTRATED HISTORY OF THE CIVIL WAR WAS PUBLISHED DURING AND SHORTLY AFTER THE CIVIL WAR, PRIMARILY BETWEEN 1861 AND 1865, BY THE PUBLISHING COMPANY FRANK LESLIE'S ILLUSTRATED NEWSPAPER. FRANK LESLIE, BORN HENRY CARTER, WAS A PROMINENT PUBLISHER KNOWN FOR HIS ILLUSTRATED NEWSPAPERS AND BOOKS, AND HIS CIVIL WAR HISTORY WAS A CONTINUATION OF HIS COMMITMENT TO COMBINING JOURNALISM WITH DETAILED VISUAL STORYTELLING. THE PUBLICATION WAS RELEASED IN A SERIES OF VOLUMES AND WEEKLY INSTALLMENTS, DESIGNED TO INFORM THE PUBLIC AS THE WAR UNFOLDED.

FOUNDING PUBLISHER AND EDITORIAL APPROACH

FRANK LESLIE WAS AN ENGLISH IMMIGRANT WHO ESTABLISHED A SUCCESSFUL ILLUSTRATED NEWSPAPER IN NEW YORK CITY.
