DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS VARY BUT GENERALLY INCLUDE PROOF OF RESIDENCY AND IDENTIFICATION. SOME SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS MAY HAVE ADDITIONAL PREREQUISITES BASED ON THE COURSE CONTENT OR CERTIFICATION STANDARDS.

REGISTRATION PROCESS
