OVERVIEW OF THE McKEES ROCKS HISTORICAL SOCIETY

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF MCKEES ROCKS

McKees Rocks, located near Pittsburgh along the Ohio River, has a rich history shaped by its strategic location and industrial development. The borough was originally inhabited by Native American tribes and later became a key site for European settlers.
