CURING OVEN

A CURING OVEN IS USED TO BAKE THE POWDER ONTO THE SUBSTRATE, RESULTING IN A DURABLE FINISH. THE OVEN SIZE AND HEATING TECHNOLOGY AFFECT COST. TYPICAL PRICES RANGE FROM \$15,000 TO \$60,000, DEPENDING ON CAPACITY AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY.

POWDER SPRAY GUN AND RECOVERY SYSTEM

THE SPRAY GUN IS ESSENTIAL FOR APPLYING POWDER EVENLY AND EFFICIENTLY. ADVANCED GUNS WITH POWDER RECOVERY SYSTEMS REDUCE WASTE AND IMPROVE ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE. PRICES FOR SPRAY GUNS START AROUND \$1,500, WITH RECOVERY SYSTEMS ADDING SEVERAL THOUSAND DOLLARS.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

FACILITY AND LOCATION EXPENSES

THE PHYSICAL LOCATION AND SIZE OF THE FACILITY SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT THE POWDER COATING BUSINESS START UP COST. THE FACILITY MUST ACCOMMODATE EQUIPMENT, STORAGE, AND WORKSPACE WHILE COMPLYING WITH ZONING LAWS AND ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS.

FACILITY SIZE AND LAYOUT
