AVERAGE SURGICAL TECHNICIAN PAY PER HOUR

THE AVERAGE SURGICAL TECHNICIAN PAY PER HOUR VARIES DEPENDING ON SEVERAL FACTORS, BUT NATIONWIDE DATA SUGGESTS A COMPETITIVE WAGE FOR THIS ESSENTIAL HEALTHCARE POSITION. CERTIFICATION BENEFITS

OBTAINING CERTIFICATION, SUCH AS THE CERTIFIED SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST (CST) CREDENTIAL, OFTEN RESULTS IN HIGHER PAY RATES. EMPLOYERS VALUE CERTIFIED TECHNICIANS FOR THEIR PROVEN SKILLS AND DEDICATION, MAKING CERTIFICATION A KEY FACTOR IN NEGOTIATING BETTER HOURLY WAGES.

REGIONAL DIFFERENCES IN SURGICAL TECHNICIAN WAGES

LOWER-PAYING REGIONS

CONVERSELY, STATES IN THE MIDWEST AND THE SOUTH MAY OFFER LOWER AVERAGE WAGES, ALTHOUGH THESE ARE OFTEN BALANCED BY A LOWER COST OF LIVING. REGIONAL ECONOMIC CONDITIONS AND HEALTHCARE FACILITY DENSITY GREATLY INFLUENCE PAY LEVELS.

EXPERIENCE AND SPECIALTY EFFECTS ON HOURLY PAY

SURGICAL TECHNICIAN VS. MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIST

MEDICAL TECHNOLOGISTS WORKING IN LABORATORIES MAY HAVE COMPARABLE OR SLIGHTLY HIGHER WAGES DEPENDING ON THEIR SPECIALIZATION AND CERTIFICATIONS, BUT THEIR WORK ENVIRONMENT AND DUTIES DIFFER SIGNIFICANTLY.
