CRITICISMS REGARDING STEREOTYPES

SOME FILMS HAVE BEEN CRITICIZED FOR REINFORCING STEREOTYPES, SUCH AS PORTRAYING STUDENTS FROM DISADVANTAGED BACKGROUNDS AS HELPLESS OR TEACHERS AS SAVIORS. THESE PORTRAYALS CAN OVERSIMPLIFY COMPLEX SOCIAL REALITIES.

ETHICAL CONCERNS IN PORTRAYALS
