UNDERSTANDING TEACHER IN SERVICE DAYS

THE FREQUENCY AND SCHEDULING OF THESE DAYS VARY BY DISTRICT, BUT THEY ARE GENERALLY INTEGRATED THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR TO SUPPORT ONGOING TEACHER DEVELOPMENT.
