ATTACHMENT STYLES AND CHEATING

ATTACHMENT THEORY ALSO PROVIDES A FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING INFIDELITY. INDIVIDUALS WITH INSECURE ATTACHMENT STYLES—SUCH AS ANXIOUS OR AVOIDANT ATTACHMENT—MAY HAVE DIFFICULTIES MAINTAINING TRUST AND INTIMACY, POTENTIALLY INCREASING THE LIKELIHOOD OF CHEATING. IN CONTRAST, SECURELY ATTACHED INDIVIDUALS TEND TO HAVE STRONGER RELATIONSHIP SATISFACTION AND LOWER RATES OF INFIDELITY.

INFLUENCE OF CULTURAL AND SOCIAL NORMS

CULTURAL BACKGROUND AND SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT PLAY A CRUCIAL ROLE IN SHAPING ATTITUDES TOWARD CHEATING AND ACTUAL INFIDELITY RATES.
