

# WHO IS MORE LIKELY TO CHEAT MEN OR WOMEN

## STATISTICAL OVERVIEW OF CHEATING AMONG MEN AND WOMEN

## BIOLOGICAL AND EVOLUTIONARY PERSPECTIVES

BIOLOGICAL AND EVOLUTIONARY THEORIES OFFER EXPLANATIONS FOR INFIDELITY TENDENCIES BASED ON GENETIC IMPERATIVES AND REPRODUCTIVE STRATEGIES. THESE PERSPECTIVES CONTRIBUTE TO UNDERSTANDING WHO IS MORE LIKELY TO CHEAT MEN OR WOMEN FROM A NATURALISTIC VIEWPOINT.

## EVOLUTIONARY THEORY

EVOLUTIONARY PSYCHOLOGY SUGGESTS THAT MEN MAY BE MORE PREDISPOSED TO CHEAT AS A STRATEGY TO INCREASE REPRODUCTIVE SUCCESS BY SPREADING GENES WIDELY. CONVERSELY, WOMEN MAY BE MORE SELECTIVE IN THEIR INFIDELITY, OFTEN SEEKING HIGH-QUALITY PARTNERS OR RESOURCES TO ENHANCE OFFSPRING SURVIVAL.

## HORMONAL INFLUENCES

HORMONES SUCH AS TESTOSTERONE AND OXYTOCIN INFLUENCE SEXUAL BEHAVIOR AND BONDING. HIGHER TESTOSTERONE LEVELS IN MEN ARE LINKED TO INCREASED SEXUAL DESIRE AND RISK-TAKING, POTENTIALLY EXPLAINING HIGHER INFIDELITY RATES. IN WOMEN, HORMONAL FLUCTUATIONS MAY AFFECT EMOTIONAL BONDING AND ATTRACTION, IMPACTING CHEATING BEHAVIOR.

# SOCIETAL AND CULTURAL INFLUENCES ON CHEATING

SOCIETAL NORMS AND CULTURAL EXPECTATIONS SIGNIFICANTLY SHAPE ATTITUDES TOWARD INFIDELITY AND AFFECT WHO IS MORE LIKELY TO CHEAT MEN OR WOMEN. THESE FACTORS INFLUENCE HOW CHEATING IS PERCEIVED, TOLERATED, AND REPORTED ACROSS DIFFERENT COMMUNITIES.

## CULTURAL ACCEPTANCE AND STIGMA

CULTURAL ACCEPTANCE OF EXTRAMARITAL AFFAIRS VARIES WIDELY. IN SOME SOCIETIES, MALE INFIDELITY IS MORE SOCIALLY TOLERATED, WHEREAS FEMALE INFIDELITY IS HARSHLY JUDGED. THIS DOUBLE STANDARD IMPACTS BOTH THE PREVALENCE OF CHEATING AND THE WILLINGNESS OF INDIVIDUALS TO DISCLOSE THEIR ACTIONS.

## IMPACT OF TECHNOLOGY AND SOCIAL MEDIA

## MYTH: YOUNGER PEOPLE CHEAT MORE

CHEATING IS NOT EXCLUSIVE TO ANY AGE GROUP. WHILE YOUNGER INDIVIDUALS MAY HAVE MORE OPPORTUNITIES, INFIDELITY OCCURS ACROSS ALL AGES AND LIFE STAGES.
